The Marion Seagull is a steel hulled wide-beam canal boat, 55-ft long and 10-ft wide, greater than the 6-ft10-in width of a narrowboat. She weighs eighteen tons, is diesel powered and is steered by a wheel.

Three of the bunk beds are 2-ft 6-in wide, the fourth being 2-ft 3-in. The three lower bunks are 1-ft 9-in above floor level.

A 27inch wide removable metal ramp provides NHS standard dimension wheelchair access from shore to the bow lift.
